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"Role of teacher educator for developing e- environment in classroom"

Research questions:

Best practices: Innovation in the classroom

In order to get answer of above mentioned research questions, Teacher educator had performed following experiment in Seva Sadan's College of Education using e- mail for self directed learning.

Mission of Seva Sadan college is to provide quality education & Life long learning. Principal Dr. Beena Khemchandani inspired all teachers to use ICT tools in teaching learning process. Seva Sadan College have well equipped library, computer laboratory, all the floors have CCTV cameras, think line in library as well as on other floors to access different library resources. Being a tech-savvy college, college has a text based communication system for the students. All the important communication is relayed to students through group SMS. College library have Soul Software for university libraries.

It is important to realize that we live in a fast changing world, dictated by the developments in technology. Quick access to information has made knowledge creation fast, & the multiplier effect has made it even explosive. It is increasingly difficult to anticipate changes & respond to them with creative purpose. Developing content through e-mail with relevance to the future & delivering it is a challenging task.

Teacher educator (myself) decided to make use of e-mail to teach & deliver the course content of ICT, Sociological foundation of Education, maths method using e-learning in the academic year 2010-11.

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Teacher educator (myself) opened new e-mail account socio.maths @gmail.com; whatever topics were taught in above mentioned subject mailed all the topics to this e-mail id. All the students got password so that they can access the content & can download it. In the year 2011-12 researcher changed the password so that Alumni can't access the e-mail Id. Some **rules** were framed to access e-mail like no one should delete the content; no one should send the e-mail without consent of researcher. Teacher educator will simply post material through e-mail; students can read it online or can download it for further access. Since the students would not be in a classroom with professor & classmate, he / she need to be capable of independent learning,

Best practices for developing e-environment in college Library:

The library of Education College plays an important role in enhancing the quality of academic & research environment. In general, the use of technology & innovative ideas leads to evolve best practices evolving in the library & information services. Due to rapid growth in literature & continuous development of information technology the role of libraries becomes more responsive. As this use of internet is increasing, a traditional library has shifted to academic library in e-environment. While advancement in communication tools were easily adapted in learning. All this calls for a team of teachers working in self financing course in different areas to come together to develop proactive strategies for higher education to meet the future demands of students.

In library, e-learning by computer can be done by communicating with professor & students via e-mail. All the professors after teaching unit can send the material, references to particular e-mail id (eg. sevasadan<u>library@gmail.com</u>). All the students will get password to access the content in library.

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Impact of Best practices:

The best practices should be implemented at every self financing institution because it will help out the best in the library & its activities. This education will be learner centred, providing full learner autonomy in education sector. Student will have all the choices open for him. He will decide what to learn, how to learn & when to learn.

Result From the feedback given by the students it is evident that

- a) It is possible to develop self directed learning atmosphere for students e-mail in self financing courses.
- b) .The self directed learning material can be developed with the help of staff and students if they are motivated.
- c) The self directed learning material developed via e-mail remains available at any time, while studying the topics using e-mail. This brings about co-cooperative learning of students.
- d) Content prepared through e-mail can be updated at any time. Student can refer the content and references for preparing assignments and examination.
- e) Teachers working in self financing college need to adopt to change if they have to survive and keep pace with new methods and technologies.
- f) All the teachers should use various tools of ICT to develop content for college library so that students can access content anywhere and anytime.

Conclusion:

Self financing colleges should realize that there is paradigm shift has been noticed in higher education now a days, from "national education" to "global education", from one time education for a few to "life long education" for all from teacher centric education to "learner centric education", traditional classroom to "e- classroom". These changes make new demands in teaching learning process.
